### THE CARMEN'S ROYAL NAVY MEDAL

*...recognises the most outstanding non-commissioned logistician of the year in any establishment, area or ship within the Navy, Marines, RFAS, including directly associated personnel.*

Founded by the Worshipful Company of Carmen in 2006. It comprises a silver gilt medal to be retained, and a framed citation.

Year*	Recipient	Citation
2018	LSC Jasmin Kackson-Tshuma	whose professionalism, dedication and unsocial hours ensured air and sea freight delivery and returns were efficiently achieved and accounted, including a complex operational support update, enhancing stock levels of critical gear, improving operational capability of deployed vessels, especially at Duqm despite lines of communication across numerous countries.
2017	LSC Sean Window	On RFA Argus, which went into refit for five months, where he maintained extensive aviation stores, spread between Plymouth, Culdrose and Falmouth, at the same time computerising 6,500 items of medical stores over 102 accounts
2016	LS Thomas Collins	for dedication, courage and achievement aboard HMS <i>Enterprise</i>
2015	WO1 Gavin White	for his ground-breaking achievement of innovative storage and information systems to support the supply chain at the start of his service, for HMS Queen Elizabeth, as her first Warrant Officer Supply Chain.
2014	LSC Ianna Parsons	for her bravura performance over 18 months in the RN's readiness deployable Forward Logistics Site (FLS) team, leading the movement of 2,000 personnel on and off RFA <i>Mounts Bay</i> .

2013	LLSC Kathleen Hynes	as the first supply chain rating in the UK maritime component commander's staff in the United Arab Emirates, establishing effective supply of high priority spares to naval assets in the Gulf
2012	PO Michael Bosworth	the second only Compliance Chief Petty Officer (Medical Assistant) appointed to the Waterfront Logistics Support Group, whose professionalism and energy corrected serious shortcomings in Portsmouth Flotilla ships' medical readiness
2011	LSC David Olive	who deployed in 2009 to Kandahar, leading a team of four tri-service junior ranks, providing 24-hour support to Sea King and Chinook forces with outstanding leadership
2010	WO Philip English	Mainstay of the 2009 watch-keeping team in the UK's Joint Force Support HQ in Afghanistan
2009	PO Richie Davenport	846 Naval Air Squadron, Afghanistan, in-theatre support for Joint Helicopter Force
2008	PO Kenneth Kennedy	Foreign liaison; support Army Battle Group, Iraq
2007	PO Peter Whittaker	Front line supply service, HMS Monmouth
